## ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM



**Give your brain a jumpstart for the academic year at Buckley Country Day Camp.** We are happy to continue to offer our Summer Academic Enrichment Program.

- Courses such as Reader's Theatre, Reading Round-Up, Math Blast, Math/Science Activities, and Spanish are available for children in the Intermediate Camp Program.
- Senior Campers can participate in Reading Round-Up, Math Blast, Code Cracking, Creative Writing, and Spanish classes.

The Enrichment Program allows children entering second grade through seventh grade the opportunity to choose interested courses. These 45-minute classes will take place during the campers' Group Games period, 2 times per week for a 2-week period. This program will not interfere with workshops, swimming lessons, or any special events. Children can register for as many courses as they are interested in to create a fabulous full-day summer experience.

## ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

### Intermediate Camp courses (entering grades 2-4)

1. **Reader's Theatre** – Children taking this course will enjoy reading story scripts and acting out simple plays. They will be practicing reading fluency, as well as learning new vocabulary and working on presenting to an audience.
2. **Reading Round-Up** – Young readers will be excited to choose a book to read with others and to take time to talk about its characters, plot, problems, and solutions. Children will have the opportunity to explore their feelings about stories through writing or creative book-related projects.
3. **Math Blast** – Can you believe you can practice your math skills and have fun at the same time? Well, you can! Children will play math related games to strengthen their math skills and increase their thinking and problem solving strategies.
4. **Junior Discovery** – Using the successful AIMS Program (Activities Integrating Math and Science) experience a variety of math and science concepts in a simple, gentle manner. Improve understanding by engaging in fun, hands-on math and science activities. Children learn best when they are involved. “I hear and I forget. I see and I remember. I do and I understand. ~ Chinese proverb” / BOBCATS ONLY (entering grade 2)
5. **Spanish is Fun** – Travel to Spain this summer without having to take the 8 hr flight! This course will expose your child to the rich language and culture of Spanish through music and interactive activities that create the atmosphere of being in a Spanish-speaking country. Students will be engaged in song and dance and motivated to use their new Spanish words in their everyday world. Students will learn basic greetings, colors, numbers, and so much more. Why not introduce your child to a skill that will last them a lifetime? Sign up for ‘Spanish is Fun’ today and join in the fun, amigos!

### Senior Camp courses – (entering grades 5-7)

1. **Reading Round-Up II** – Readers will enjoy choosing a book to read together and discussing their thoughts in a small group setting. Campers will have the opportunity to expand their vocabulary and learn how to analyze and evaluate what they read, while putting their thoughts down using creative hands-on literary activities.
2. **Math Blast II** – Strengthen your age-appropriate math skills, and apply them to real life problem solving situations. Through games and activities, campers will develop strategies and gain confidence in their mathematical abilities.
3. **Code Cracking** – Stretch your mind and learn how to strengthen your logic, reasoning, and math skills. You'll be engaged in fun and challenging brainteaser puzzles that will teach you how to examine, organize, and focus your thoughts in order to crack the code. Are you game?
4. **Young Writers** – “Writing lets other people in on your dreams.” “When you write – it's only you on paper.” “My pencil lets out ideas I would never tell anyone.” Campers will work through the writing process including development, writing, and revision, while having the opportunity to produce creative writing pieces reflecting their own interests and ideas.
